Class 1 - Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 318. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams). Qualifies for: 85cms National Amateur Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 85cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 85cm Second Round competition. The winner of a particular 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £88.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 2a/b - KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice - First Round/90cm Open

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by KBIS Insurance Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. British Novice: Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2014 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6 Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular KBIS Insurance British Novice competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. 90cm Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or

more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £12.00, Total: £86.00. **Entry Fee = £12.00**

Class 3 - Dodson & Horrell 95cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 320. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams). Qualifies for: 95cms National Amateur Second Rounds Qualifying period: 1st September - 31st August inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 95cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 95cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 95cm Second Round competition. The winner of a particular 95cm National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £88.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 4a/b - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. Discovery: a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2013 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. 1.00m Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £94.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 5 - Dodson & Horrell 1.05m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 322. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams). Qualifies for: 1.05m National Amateur Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.05m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.05m Second Round competition. The winner of a particular 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £16.00, 5th: £16.00, Total: £122.00. **Entry Fee = £15.00**

Class 6 - Dodson & Horrell 1.10m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 324. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams). Qualifies for: 1.10m National Amateur Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which

jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.10m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first, round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.10m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.10m Second Round competition. The winner of a particular 1.10m National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £18.00, 6th: £18.00, Total: £166.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 7 - National 1.15m Members Cup Qualifier

Rule 294. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who are not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017. Qualifies for: British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification period: 1st June-31st May. Numbers to qualify: Four double clears (subject to revision). Qualification is horse/rider combination.

Prizes: 1st: £60.00, 2nd: £45.00, 3rd: £35.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £180.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

1. Organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to the showground.
 2. The organisers accept no responsibility for accidents, theft or loss whatsoever arising out of the show.
 3. No entry will be accepted without the correct entry fee.
 4. *Refund of entry fee.*
 - a. Cancellation must be made in accordance with British Show Jumping Rule 79.4
 5. The organisers reserve the right to restrict the number of entries to 30 in each class.
 - a. Each Horse or Pony can only compete once in each class
 6. Depending on the progress of the show, the organisers reserve the right to switch classes between rings.
 7. Stallions will be permitted in accordance with BS Rule 82.2a
 8. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
 9. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
 10. Hats of the correct standard (PAS 015, ASTM F1163) or above must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
 11. Medical Cover is in accordance with BS Rule 73.8e.
 12. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the class, by the owner, his authorised agent or the rider, and logged with the secretary.
 13. The Judge's decision is always final.
 14. Our Unaffiliated Showjumping evenings are open to Chard Equestrian members only. 2017 membership fee of £1 will be payable with your first entry fee.
 15. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6
