Class 1a/b - School's 70cm League Class

Schools (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 70cm.

Open to teams and individuals aged between 5 and 19 years old (the years in which the rider turns 5 and 19). Excluding any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Gold League during their competition history. In case of teams, this class cannot run as a Two Phase competition (only Table A7 and Single Phase). The 3 highest scores count. Points are awarded on the following basis: 1st – 12 points, 2nd- 10 points, 3rd – 8 points, 4th – 6 points, 5th – 4 points, 6th – 3 points. 3 points will be allocated to all those who achieve a double clear; those who are placed will receive an additional 3 points if they have had a double clear. To be eligible for league points, the relevant team and individual forms need to be filled and sent to British Showjumping. Class 2a/b - School's 80cm League Class

Schools (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Open to teams and individuals aged between 5 and 19 years old (the years in which the rider turns 5 and 19). Excluding any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Gold League during their competition history. In case of teams, this class cannot run as a Two Phase competition (only Table A7 and Single Phase). The 3 highest scores count. Points are awarded on the following basis: 1st – 12 points, 2nd- 10 points, 3rd – 8 points, 4th – 6 points, 5th – 4 points, 6th – 3 points. 3 points will be allocated to all those who achieve a double clear; those who are placed will receive an additional 3 points if they have had a double clear. To be eligible for league points, the relevant team and individual forms need to be filled and sent to British Showjumping. Class 3a/b - School's 90cm League Class

Schools (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Open to teams and individuals aged between 5 and 19 years old (the years in which the rider turns 5 and 19). Excluding any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Gold League during their competition history.

In case of teams, this class cannot run as a Two Phase competition (only Table A7 and Single Phase).

The 3 highest scores count. Points are awarded on the following basis: 1st – 12 points, 2nd- 10 points, 3rd – 8 points, 4th – 6 points, 5th – 4 points, 6th – 3 points. 3 points will be allocated to all those who achieve double clear; those who are placed will receive an additional 3 points if they have had a double clear.

Class 4a/b - School's 1.00m League Class

Schools (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Open to teams and individuals aged between 5 and 19 years old (the years in which the rider turns 5 and 19).

In case of teams, this class cannot run as a Two Phase competition (only Table A7 and Single Phase).

The 3 highest scores count. Points are awarded on the following basis: 1st – 12 points, 2nd- 10 points, 3rd – 8 points, 4th – 6 points, 5th – 4 points, 6th – 3 points. 3 points will be allocated to all those who achieve double clear; those who are placed will receive an additional 3 points if they have had a double clear.

Class 5 - not before 12:00 - Pony British Novice Championship - First Round /80cm Open

Rule 410. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. British Novice: For registered ponies in Grade JD and JC that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13. Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. 80cm Open: For registered ponies to be ridden by Junior Members. If combined with an open: In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £20.00, 2nd: £15.00, 3rd: £14.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £77.00. **Entry Fee = £12.00**

Class 6 - Pony Discovery -First Round/90cm Open

Rule 408. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm. Discovery: For registered ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 300 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13. Qualifies for: Pony Discovery Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify for: Those ponies which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Discovery First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Discovery Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony Discovery First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. 90cm Open: For registered ponies, to be ridden by Junior Members. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £16.00, 5th: £16.00, Total: £93.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 7 - Blue Chip Pony Newcomers/Pony 1.00m Open (both to inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Qualifier)

Rule 406 & 416. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip. Blue Chip Pony Newcomers is for registered Ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members. Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. First Rosette in the Pony Newcomers section sponsored by Blue Chip. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Newcomers Section, ridden by Junior Members who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship. Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/rider Combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final. Ponies may compete in one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £16.00, 5th: £16.00, Total: £100.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 8 - Pony Foxhunter/1.10m Open (both to Inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Qualifier)

Rule 404 & 417. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members. Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, ridden by Junior members who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship. Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

Prizes: 1st: £35.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £18.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £116.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Class 9 - Junior 1.20m Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members.

Prizes: 1st: £60.00, 2nd: £45.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £18.00, 6th: £18.00, Total: £191.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

 - a. Each Horse or Pony can only compete once in each class
 6. Depending on the progress of the show, the organisers reserve the right to switch classes between rings.
 7. Stallions will be permitted in accordance with BS Rule 82.2a
 8. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
 9. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
 10. Hats of the correct standard (PAS 015, ASTM F1163) or above must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
 11. Medical Cover is in accordance with BS Rule 73.8e.
 12. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the class, by the owner, his authorised agent or the rider, and logged with the secretary.
 13. The Judge's decision is always final.
 14. Our Unaffiliated Showjumping evenings are open to Chard Equestrian members only. 2017 membership fee of £1 will be payable with your first entry fee.
 15. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6
