Class 1 - KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice - First Round

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by KBIS Insurance. Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. British Novice: Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2014 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6 Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular KBIS Insurance British Novice competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. Class 1 & 2 will run consecutively with one course walk & one prize giving.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £88.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 2 - Senior 90cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

Category 2 shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. Class 1 & 2 will run consecutively with one course walk & one prize giving.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £88.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 3 - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery - First Round

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members .a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2013 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Category 2 shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. Class 3 & 4 will run consecutively with one course walk & one prize giving.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £94.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 4 - Senior 1.00m Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

Category 2 shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. Class 3 & 4 will run consecutively with one course walk & one prize giving.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £94.00. **Entry Fee = £14.00**

Class 5 - Senior 1.05m Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £16.00, 5th: £16.00, Total: £122.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 6 - Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers - First Round/1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. Newcomers: (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6 (b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2012, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive. 1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £18.00, 6th: £18.00, Total: £166.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Class 7 - Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round/1.20m Open

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. Foxhunter section: (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6 (b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2011, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify. Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive. Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2017 are not eligible for qualification to the 2018 Championship. Open section: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £75.00, 2nd: £60.00, 3rd: £40.00, 4th: £25.00, 5th: £20.00, 6th: £20.00, Total: £240.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 8 - National 1.30m Open

Rule 306. Single Phase. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members. Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify.

Prizes: 1st: £100.00, 2nd: £75.00, 3rd: £50.00, 4th: £35.00, 5th: £25.00, 6th: £25.00, Total: £310.00. **Entry Fee = £25.00**

Class 9 - National 1.40m Open

Rule 301. Single Phase. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.40m.

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Qualifies for: 1.40m Grand Prix at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st July - 30th June Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify for the final. Also any two double clears from any International Trial or Area Trial or classes 1.40m or above in the qualifying period will qualify for the Final.

Prizes: 1st: £125.00, 2nd: £100.00, 3rd: £75.00, 4th: £50.00, 5th: £30.00, Total: £380.00. **Entry Fee = £28.00**

1. Organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to the showground.
 2. The organisers accept no responsibility for accidents, theft or loss whatsoever arising out of the show.
 3. No entry will be accepted without the correct entry fee.
 4. *Refund of entry fee.*
 - a. Cancellation must be made in accordance with British Show Jumping Rule 79.4
 5. The organisers reserve the right to restrict the number of entries to 30 in each class.
 - a. Each Horse or Pony can only compete once in each class
 6. Depending on the progress of the show, the organisers reserve the right to switch classes between rings.
 7. Stallions will be permitted in accordance with BS Rule 82.2a
 8. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
 9. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
 10. Hats of the correct standard (PAS 015, ASTM F1163) or above must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
 11. Medical Cover is in accordance with BS Rule 73.8e.
 12. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the class, by the owner, his authorised agent or the rider, and logged with the secretary.
 13. The Judge's decision is always final.
 14. Our Unaffiliated Showjumping evenings are open to Chard Equestrian members only. 2017 membership fee of £1 will be payable with your first entry fee.
 15. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6
