MELPLASH UNAFFILIATED SHOWJUMPING QUALIFIER

All advanced entries £7.00/class (AVPC members £6.00). Entries on the day £8.50/class (AVPC £7.50)

Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Trophies to the winning combinations. All AVPC members to wear white armband in order to be eligible for Best Axe Vale rosette.

RING ONE

- Class 1 Novice Show Jumping (70cm) for combinations not to have won any show Jumping competition.
- Class 2 70cm Open
- Class 3 80cm Open
- Class 4 90cm Open – Qualifier for Melplash Show, for any rider under 16 years.

All heights are approximate and for the first round. Fences will be raised for jump off.

RING TWO

- Class 5 Mini Working hunter, under 13hh, fences approx. 50cm. Riders may be lead and will not be asked to canter collectively
- Class 6 Novice Working Hunter, fences 60 - 70 cm. Combinations not to have won any Working Hunter Competition.
- Class 7 Open Working Hunter, under 15hh. Fences 70 - 80cm
- Class 8 Open Working Hunter, over 15hh. Fences 80 - 90cm
- Class 9 Ridden Hunter, under 14.2hh
- Class 10 Ridden Hunter, over 14.2hh

Championship for highest placed Axe Vale Member in classes 5 – 10

RING THREE

- Class 11 Lead Rein. Pony to not exceed 12.2. Rider 12 years and under

Class 12 First Ridden. Off lead rein, pony not to exceed 13.2. Rider 16 years and under.
Will not be expected to canter collectively.

*In the above classes, no grass reins, daisy reins or attachments to the saddle will be permitted.
Snaffle bridles only.*

RING THREE (Continued)

Class 13 Mini-Major Pairs. Under 13.2, rider 16 years and under to be partnered with over 15hh, rider 16 years and over.

Class 14 Best Pony Club Pony. Under 14.2, rider any age.

Class 15 Best Pony Club/Riding Club Horse. Over 14.2, rider any age.

Class 16 Best Family Pony. Suitable for all members of the family

Class 17 Best cob. To be shown hogged or unplaited (traditional)

Championship for highest placed Axe Vale Member in classes 11 – 17

RING FOUR (IN-HAND)

Class 18 Best coloured or spotted

Class 19 Mountain and Moorland

Class 20 Best youngster (under 4 years old)

Class 21 Best veteran (over 18 years old)

Class 22 Best child handler

Championship for highest placed Axe Vale Member in classes 18 – 22

Class 23 Fancy Dress (either in-hand or ridden)

RING FIVE

Clear Round Jumping, 09.30 – 12 noon (entries taken at ringside, £1.50 or £2.00 to include rosette)

From 12.30:

Class 24 Junior Show Jumping, Lead rein only. Max height 30cm

Class 25 Junior Show Jumping, may be assisted. Max height 45 cm

Class 26 Junior Show jumping. Max height 60cm

Class 27 Junior Show Jumping. Max height 70cm

Competitors competing in classes 24 – 27 are not permitted to compete in classes 1 – 4, and vice versa.
