**New Rules – Please note that we are trying to run classes for everyone, therefore we request competitors adhere to the following rules. This will help us to get through all the classes in a reasonable time.**

1. All Classes will be jumped in a set order.
2. You must declare at the ringside at least 15 minutes before the start of your class.
3. Please state clearly on your entry form, what section you are competing in for a mixed height class.
4. The course will be available to walk for a short time **ONLY** prior to each class. Please be ready to walk, all those competing to walk the course together, we will not hold up the course walk if you are late!
5. Please enter the ring in TROT and proceed straight to the first fence, **DO NOT** halt by the judge. After jumping the last fence leave the arena in trot, **DO NOT** stop and salute. Proceed to collecting ring of show/conformation ring.
6. Please note that rosettes will be presented in the conformation ring.

**BSHA WORKING SHOW HORSE**

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Competitors and Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Riders must be 15 years old or over. Qualifiers for the SEIB Working Show Horse of the Year Championship, to be held at the BSHA National Championship Show. The two highest placed horses, in the top five, not already qualified in each Open Working Show Horse class, will qualify for the Championship; no horse placed lower than fifth will qualify. Any Horse which is a Grade B Showjumper, Intermediate Eventer, or above, as at the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year, is not eligible to compete in any Working Show Horse class. A Rider may ride up to two Horses in the jumping phase but must then select on Horse to take through to the Ride and Conformation phases (if required). No change of Rider is allowed. Horses may wear protective boots, of a plain colour, for the jumping phase only; no weighted boots are permitted, no change of tack is permitted between jumping and flat phases.

The Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband only and held in the Leader's outside hand. Affiliated to South West Ponies.

**Class 62:The NPS M & M First Ridden Stevenson Brothers WHP**

Mares and geldings four years old or over, not exceeding 128 cms, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Rider over 5 years but under 12 years (see rules in section A 3.2). Riders who have qualified for the (Horse of the Year Show or RIHS) M&M WHP Championship before 1st January in the current year, on any pony, are not eligible.

**\*This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part whether a member or not shall be deemed to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.**

**\*The Show is also affiliated to the British Show Horse Association and the relevant classes will be judged under their rules**

**\*This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Summer Championship Show 2019. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in the Open Nursery and Open WHPs Open SHPs Open L/R F/R and Open Show Pony classes will qualify. The 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Open Intermediate classes..**

**This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Binks Family 50<sup>th</sup> Year Golden Anniversary Champion of Champions, the 1<sup>st</sup> prize winners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead rein, first Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate SH & SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes.**

**This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS The White Company Mini WHP Champion of Champions. The 1<sup>st</sup> prize winner in the Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes will qualify.**

**\*This show is a qualifier for the 2019 Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first 3 will qualify in the following classes: Open LR, Open F/R, Open Nursery Stakes, Open 133cm 143cm and 153cm WHP, L/R of HT, Open 122cm 133cm, 143 cm & 153 cm SHP, Open Intermediate SRT small and large, Open & Pretty Polly Heritage Ridden, Intermediate SH & WH, Pretty Polly Heritage LR & Heritage 1<sup>st</sup> Ridden, Pretty Polly Mixed Height Show Pony, Pretty Polly Mixed Height SHP, Heritage LR and 1<sup>st</sup> Ridden & Heritage Open Ridden. In these classes ponies must be owned and ridden by a BSPS Member. Except for the Anglo and Part-bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS.**

Challenge. Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any B.S.P.S. affiliated Show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2019 Horse of The Year Show in the appropriate class.

**\*The Blue Riband Pony of the Year competition:** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> placed prize winners in each of the Open WHP, SHP, Open Show Pony, L/R and 1<sup>st</sup> Ridden classes and 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in the Open Intermediate WH, SRT & SH classes will qualify. Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with Blue Riband qualification.

**\*Neither the BSPS nor the committee, any Judge, Steward or any other Official shall be liable** for injury or damage to any person, animal, article or property. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor or competitor shall indemnify the organisers and hold them harmless against such matters aforesaid.

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. All PAS015, VG1, (BS)EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged..

A rider whose hat comes off will be eliminated. A rider whose strap comes undone, whilst competing must on Penalty of Elimination replace it or fasten it before continuing. He may stop without penalty to fasten the strap..

In the interest of Health & Safety the B.S.P.S. Council are determined that riders must comply with Rule 45. The B.S.P.S. will authorise spot checks at certain Shows and riders breaking this Rule will not be allowed to compete.

#### **\* BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION ROYAL INTERNATIONAL QUALIFYING CLASSES**

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all owners, exhibitors and riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

Classes 25 to 32 are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse Classes. The three highest placed prizewinners in all **OPEN** affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show in September 2019

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each **OPEN** class and a Champion rosette for each section (except for Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes). The Association will also award an Amateur Home Produced rosette in Affiliated Open Cob (Lightweight & Heavyweight only) classes. These rosettes have been kindly sponsored by TSG, Mr. L Turley. The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year.

The highest placed Amateur Home Produced exhibit in all Royal International qualifying classes will need to contact Sarah Butler by e-mail [sarah@bluechipfeed.com](mailto:sarah@bluechipfeed.com) or on 0114 266 6200 (a maximum of one rosette to be won at a RIHS qualifier and one rosette at a HOYS qualifier per horse. The award will then pass down the line)..

### **NPS/PICTON M & M Novice Ridden National Championship**

- a. Stallions, mares and geldings, 4 years old or over, registered in the main body of Respective Breed Society Stud Book. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year, it has done any of the following:
  1. Won an open Affiliated mixed M & M Ridden Class.
  2. Qualified for HOYS, Olympia or RIHS Open M & M Ridden classes.
  3. Qualified for the M & M Novice or Intermediate Ridden Final at the NPS Summer Championship Show (nb ponies can compete as Novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year)
  4. If a pony qualifies for HOYS, Olympia or RIHS in its second year, it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.
- b. Rider any age, except Stallions (see Rules in Section A3.2).
- c. The Owner does not have to be an NPS Member for the pony to enter this competition, but only ponies owned by NPS qualifying or life members can qualify for the final.
- d. The highest placed pony, owned by an NPS member, in each class goes forward to the final. Where this pony has already qualified, the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS Member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than third place.
- e. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.
- f. A Minimum of six ponies must be stripped in qualifying rounds. All ponies must be stripped in the NPS final.

### **PONIES ASSOCIATION (UK)**

Classes 47 to 50 are to be judged according to the rules and regulations of Ponies Association (UK).

Owners must be Adult/Life Members; Riders must be current Ponies UK Annual Members.

Ponies must be currently registered with Ponies (UK) before time of entry in order to compete in these classes.

Open to Mountain & Moorland Ridden Stallions (Intermediate classes only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over.

Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books or Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D.

The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the Ponies (UK) RIHS Young Riders or Amateur classes at the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead in July 2019.

### **Ponies (UK) Amateur Rule**

- (A) **Amateur Status** – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:
  - (i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity
  - (ii) Receive remuneration for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
  - (iii) Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment
  - (iv) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, **or act as a Brand Ambassador or Supported Person**, in **any** showing classes, Ponies (UK) or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned.
- (i) A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in **any** Open classes, Ponies (UK) or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working Show Horse and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show.

**The above Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and only ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership.**
- (ii) On the day when an Exhibit is competing in an Amateur class, Professionals are not allowed to ride or work-in the relevant animal. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
- (B) **Amateur Owner/Rider.** Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur, (the Rider need not be the Owner of the Horse). This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. **No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.**
- (C) **Amateur Home Produced.** Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. **No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.**

## **RIHS BSPA COLOUREDS**

Classes 33 to 36 are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead on Tuesday 23rd July 2019. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules which can be downloaded from [www.bspa.online.com](http://www.bspa.online.com). All horses and ponies must be registered and all owners and riders must be BSPA members prior to the show. Riders age taken from the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must have a current JMB height certificate.

**NEW WORDING** Competitors qualifying at this show for the Royal International Horse Show 23<sup>rd</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> July 2019 must submit their entries by recorded delivery post with full payment within 48 hours of qualifying to The Showing Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex, RH17 5NU. Schedules and entry forms can be downloaded at [www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-and-results/the-longines-royal-international-horse-show/](http://www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-and-results/the-longines-royal-international-horse-show/).

All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA or hold a BSPA showing permit (contact BSPA for Stallion Showing Permit information) for 2019 and have a BSPA stallion ID card, and wear a BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 years old may exhibit a stallion in any class. No competitors / Owners/Horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2019 membership of BSPA and a RIHS qualification card.

**Membership/Horse Registrations must be in place before you enter classes.**

Qualification: 1<sup>st</sup> place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> will qualify from each class. No competitor lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> may qualify. Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class will qualify for amateur and junior supreme championship finals to be held at the BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2019 at the College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe, Beds. Cards to be shown and qualification cards signed. All Champion and Reserve Champion winners qualify for the BSPA Star Championship at WCC.
